






Battle Copacking

Battle Copacking announced plans to invest \$13.6M and create 20 jobs. The company will occupy a new 128,000 sf building in Deerfield Business Park, Mooresville, NC.

BestCo

Bestco announced an expansion of \$177M and the creation of 399 jobs. The company will expand their manufacturing and distribution facilities at Mooresville Business Park East. The expansion will bring their total footprint in Mooresville to over 1M sf and employment over 1,000 people.

C.R. Onsrud

C.R. Onsrud announced a \$17M expansion and the creation of 25 jobs. The company will expand their existing building and construct an additional building on an adjacent lot in Troutman.

Jeld-Wen, Inc.

Jeld-Wen invested \$7.9M in their new VPI Quality Windows facility located in Statesville, NC. The 112,500 sf facility will employ 235 people.

Keselowski Advanced Manufacturing

Keselowski Advanced Manufacturing (KAM) announced an expansion of \$5M and the creation of 10 jobs. KAM is vertically integrated, through simulation and design engineering, serial production manufacturing, additive manufacturing, and CNC capabilities.

Liburdi

Liburdi announced an expansion of \$1.2M and the creation of 7 new jobs. The investment will shorten lead times an enable them to service a new product line of military engine parts.

Origin Food Group

Origin Food Group announced \$3M expansion with the creation of 40 new jobs. The company will add a production line at the Statesville facility for it's growing client base.

Sherwin-Williams

Sherwin-Williams announced a \$324M investment and the creation of 183 jobs. The project includes the 36,000 sf expansion at their current facility and the construction of a new 800,000 sf distribution facility in Statesville.

Product Development







7.7M SF

Iredell EDC focuses on product development by enabling the community to maintain and strengthen its economic competitiveness through the development of sites and promoting buildings. Iredell EDC has announced 6 product development projects with investments totaling over \$675 M with the creation of 7.7 M sf. Currently in the pipeline there are 20 active projects representing 15+ M sf. If fully actualized the capital investments would total over \$1B.

77 North Logistics Center

The 77 North Logistics Center, 159 acre development, is an industrial park in Troutman located off of Highway 21. The proposed development is for two industrial buildings totaling 1.7 M sf, representing a capital investment of \$150,000,000. The development is represented by TPA Group based in Atlanta, GA.

Moooresville Business Park East Speculative Building

Mooresville Business Park East Specuatlive Building is being developed by Wilcombs LLC, a partnership between G.L. Wilson Building Co. and McCombs Steel. The partnership has broken ground on approximately 111,488 sf of speculative manufacturing building located in Mooresville, NC. The site includes 20.51 acres with the ability to expand the building up to 83,616 sf.

NC Park 40/77

Northpoint Development, a real estate development firm, is developing approximately 400 acres located at the northeast intersection of Interstates I-77 and I-40, north of Statesville, NC. The finished development will comprise of over 3.2 million square feet of industrial facilities. Approximately \$215 M in capital investment.

North Charlotte Commerce

North Charlotte Commerce is an industrial development at Deerfield Business Park in Mooresville. The project will be 710,640 sf of industrial development and is being represented by Strategic Real Estate Partners based in Atlanta, GA.

Statesville Commerce Center

Statesville Commerce Center is an industrial development site off Highway 70. The proposed development is for two buildings totaling 633,837 sf. The development is represented by Williams Development Group based in Winston-Salem.

Statesville Logistics Park

Statesville Logistics Park, TPA Group's second project in Iredell County, is comprised of 185 acres. The site is located at the northwest gateway of Highway 77 and Highway 21, exit 54. The first building will consist of a 1 M sf and expandable to 1.4 M sf.



Existing Industry

Iredell Industry Leaders Councils

On March 2, Iredell EDC hosted a virtual Industry Leaders Council. Meredith Teague, President of AIRBOX Air Purifiers spoke about the company's growth and the clean air system.

Kami Baggett, regional manager for NC State University, Industry Expansion Solutions (IES), shared how IES helps industry across the state with their needs and how the ReVamp program can assist motorsports companies looking to diversify.

On June 1, Iredell EDC will host the 3rd quarter ILC at NGK Cermanics which will be the first in person meeting since the start of the pandemic. The agenda will include a facility tour, industry discussion around innovation, and how NGK utilizes a measurement system, Failure Severity Rate, for machine up/down time.

Assistance & Referrals

Iredell EDC continues the existing industry outreach program and as a result project activity remains strong with 19 projects in various stages of the pipeline. Our efforts have led to 162 referrals for companies such as—85 referrals were workforce, 22 real estate, and 60 business assistance—connecting them with building, expansion information, zoning, business-to-business connections, grant information, and utility services just to mention a few.

ReVamp

The Town of Mooresville and Iredell County have approved \$260,000 (\$100,000 and \$160,000, respectively) for technical assistance grants to companies participating in ReVamp, which launched in May 2021. As of April 30, 2022, Iredell EDC remains at three participating companies in the ReVamp program: HMS Motorsports, JRi Shocks, and Kyle Busch Motorsports(KBM). KBM has progressed by completing the selfassessment and is now reviewing areas of opportunities.

In March, outreach occurred to all NASCAR-related companies to engage them in a conversation about ReVamp. We continue to promote the program through social media, newsletters, and on a separate landing page.

Workforce & Talent

Iredell Ready

Iredell Industry & Education Alliance

Iredell EDC is leading a new workforce initiative called "Iredell Ready" to identify, align, and enhance strategic priorities across the workforce development pipeline from early childhood education to retirement. The collaborative between industry and workforce partners will strengthen relationships and identify key priorities to meet the current and growing needs of industry by ensuring the workforce is skilled and ready to work.

Iredell Ready was initiated, founded, and funded by key workforce partners including: Iredell-Statesville Schools, Mooresville Graded School District, Greater Statesville Chamber of Commerce, Centralina Workforce Development Board, Mitchell Community College, and Iredell County Economic Development Corporation.

In March, we presented a proposal and formal request for funding to the Iredell County Board of Commissioners. As a result, the initiative was granted \$375,000 in matching funds, over a three year period, providing the initiative with a total of \$750,000 in funding.

Industry engagement and alignment are integral to ensuring the work set forth is relevant and responsive to the needs of industry. In May, we asked 15 key employers representing Iredell's 6 key industry sectors (information technology, healthcare, logistics and distribution, manufacturing, agriculture, and finance) to participate in a survey to better define the goals, objectives, and metrics. The results of the survey was shared on May 18, 2022 at the first kick-off meeting for Iredell Ready. The meeting included representatives from industry and workforce partners.

Key Next steps:

- We have selected Springer Studios to help us with a comprehensive marketing strategy and have formed a marketing committee to steer the work for this effort.
- Finalizing metrics for the initiative and identifying and building out a CRM system to track and report our collaborative efforts
- Enhanced engagement with industry and workforce partners across Iredell County
